

Clerks Report (Includes Matters Arising from May meeting) – September 2018

Cemetery Wall – Contractor started repairs on wall and believe he maybe finished, Clerk needs to contact him

Handyman Services – He has installed the second new dog bin on Church Road/Back Lane junction.

Tree Management – The Clerk is progressing communciations with the Diocese of Ely and the reporting contractor in order to finalise work identified to trees within the Churchyard.

Memorial Safety – Five families have come forward of the 17 laid down initially. A notice is being placed in G4 to encourage people to come forward and for other memorials.

Street lighting – The work was finalised on 17 July apart from two and is on September agenda.

Barley Straw Bales – Cllr Pammie Walker upon investigation was able to confirm that they will stay in the pond as they improve in time in tackling algae.

Defibrillator – This was taken in August for the first time, though was not needed. It is now back in situ and registered back on the system with the ambulance service.

Public Space Protection Order – The Principle Officer, Environmental Health at the Borough Council advised that this order belongs to them as such and any public spaces come under the order that they apply for. They will contact PC's in the near future with proposals and then go to formal consultation as required by law. Should the consultation be successful then any land included would be covered by the Councils Public Space Protection Order.

Drainage Near Pub – Highways Manager advised that the pipes and drains had been flushed out which should resolve issues for now.

Wereham Pond Path – This did not get adopted by NCC and will not be adopted by them at this time.

The Row Drainage – The Highways Manager was awaiting a date at last update end of August.
