

## Defibrillator Funding Update Note

At the previous meeting it was agreed to discuss the membership of the defibrillator.

Gold Membership is £500 per annum and needs to be **purchased for a minimum of 4 years**. Therefore the Parish Council will need to decide January 2020 the membership required at that point.

Memberships includes

- Electrode replacements, replacement batteries, annual service check on defib and cabinet, load defib if it out of action for more than 3 days, WebNos governance system, counselling, theft and damage insurance, rescue data download service (if required), annual refresher training/awareness session (this is recommended),(max 50 persons) money put in ESCROW Trust for replacement of your defibrulator after the manufacturer's warranty period.

blue – Basic

Bronze – Basic plus Bronze

Silver – Basic, Bronze plus Silver

Gold – Basic, Bronze, Silver plus Gold

The gold membership covers for all warranty, breakdowns, training and insurances plus any replacements in the future. The total cost to replace would be £2k.

Funding applied for Community Awareness training £175 is included in the package invoiced for and therefore you could ask the Lottery to use the money in other ways such as printing leaflets for distribution around the village or new fridge magnets or keyrings.

Line rental will need to be budgeted for annually at £52 through Heartbeat Trust.

Ambulance service will provide the training session once installed

They can provide free Doctor ABC cards and poster size.

The Parish Council need to consider

- Does it agree to spending the £175 to raise awareness through key rings, magnets or flyers if lottery approve?
- Approve the invoice payment to Heartbeat Trust wholly from funding from the lottery?
