1. Forms of nomination can be obtained from the Returning Officer, King's Court, Chapel Street, King's Lynn, PE30 1EX who will, at the request of an elector for any electoral area, prepare a nomination paper for signature.
2. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer, King's Court, Chapel Street, King's Lynn, PE30 1EX on any day after the date of this notice during normal office hours but no later than **4 pm on Thursday 8 May 2025**. Where possible, can candidates please make an appointment with the Returning Officer in order that their nomination can be handed in by this deadline. Any request for an appointment should be made via email at: **[elections@west-norfolk.gov.uk](mailto:elections@west-norfolk.gov.uk)** or telephone **01553 616773**.
3. If the election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday 5 June 2025**.
4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at King's Court, Chapel Street, King's Lynn, PE30 1EX by **midnight on Monday 19 May 2025**. Applications can be made online: **[www.gov.uk/registertovote](http://www.gov.uk/registertovote)**
5. New postal vote applications (including proxies applying to vote by post), changes or cancellations to existing postal, postal proxy or proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at King's Court, Chapel Street, King's Lynn, PE30 1EX by **5 pm on Tuesday 20 May 2025**.
6. New applications to vote by proxy (not postal proxy) at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at King's Court, Chapel Street, King's Lynn, PE30 1EX by **5 pm on Wednesday 28 May 2025**.
7. Applications for Voter Authority Certificates must be made by **5 pm on Wednesday 28 May 2025**.
8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Kings Court, Chapel Street, King's Lynn, PE30 1EX by **5 pm on Thursday 5 June 2025**. The physical incapacity must have occurred after **5 pm on Wednesday 28 May 2025**. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after **5 pm on Wednesday 28 May 2025**.
